This creates the opportunity for new members of each group in 2024. Each has a distinct role. The Pastoral Council focuses on the vision and mission of the parish. It doesn't have to run all the programs, but rather, discerns prayerfully, listening to parishioners and advising how best the parish can assist people in



# A CATECHIST'S REFLECTION by Donagh D'Silva

It was ten years ago after Sunday mass when a plea was made for more Catechists to teach scripture in public schools. I volunteered immediately and have enjoyed every minute of the ten years at a high school teaching years 7, 8 and 9 alternately. Taking the world of today and the excitement of discovering Jesus into a classroom is a blessing most teachers would dream of.

The Religious Education curriculum states "that Catechists with the assistance of the spirit, lead both children and their families to deepen their responses as disciples". The Pathways of Discipleship folder offers all the resource material required. The mentoring and in services are ongoing cementing in the teachers.

Essentially you go in there and share your love and friendship with Jesus. Show them how his kindness and compassion shaped your own relationship with Jesus and others. Through music, song, visuals and drama children experience for themselves the unshakable love God has for his children revealed in Scripture. I must confess I have sneaked in the Jesuit Gerard Manley Hopkin's psalm inspired poem 'Thou art indeed just O Lord' and W. B Yeats' 'The Second Coming' to emphasise God's intrinsic presence in literature which reflects life.

Please give it a shot and after a few months when the children thank you with a smile on their way out you know in your heart you are doing your bit with the Holy Spirit guiding you along. Armed with your own love of Jesus and his love for you and the joy of imparting that is all that you need.
