

No 9.30am Mass on Holy Thursday April 6th. No 9.15am Mass on Easter Saturday April 8th.

While everyone is welcome to every liturgy, it is worth noting that the Lord's Passion at 3pm on Good Friday is a longer and very solemn service, less suitable for young children. Likewise the Easter Vigil is a longer service.

Stations of the Cross at St Gerard's on Good Friday will be an outdoor procession again this year, which we think might be more engaging especially for children who find it hard to sit still. We will gather in the lower carpark, adjacent to the hall. *Carpark gates will be closing after 9.50am* to ensure pedestrian safety, so please arrive early. This will go ahead regardless of weather. The church will be open for people with limited mobility who are unable to stand for 45 minutes or walk 200 meters, to pray the Stations privately.

The back gate onto Roselea Way will be open for Easter services at St Gerard's.

The **Easter 8.30am and 9.30am Masses** will include children's involvement as usual, and the Sunday evening Masses at both churches will be tailored to teenagers and young adults and their families.

Fasting on Good Friday: Good Friday is a day of fasting, including abstinence from meat. BUT - Bishop Anthony's Lenten Penance notice highlights that "This Lenten Practice is not to be a burden

upon those who have health issues or special needs". This is also true of the one hour fast before receiving Communion. Many people remember the time when this discipline was to fast from midnight, and still attempt to do this, but this can be problematic for older people who need to maintain their hydration and blood sugar levels. Please be gentle with yourself. The fast is for an hour before Communion, not the start of Mass, meaning that it should be quite possible to have breakfast before coming to Mass, and arrive replenished and ready to engage fully in Mass.

The strict fasting of Good Friday (skipping a meal, having only light meals, etc) including abstinence from meat applies to people aged 14-60 only. Perhaps a greater fast for many of us might be from all screens and entertainment, to let the day be one of quiet reflection on what Jesus has done out of his love for us.
