



I was born into a Hindu family, and I suppose that one aspect sparked a bit of curiosity among people. I've had members of the parish approach me and ask, "What made you take this step?" I guess some are looking to hear a story or perhaps wondering if a situation or circumstance brought me closer to Christ.

But the truth is actually quite simple. I fell in love.

In love with a man whose wisdom was beyond my understanding, whose way of life was justified, and whose love is everlasting"





An excerpt from Teruo's testimony:

"Before this journey, I was unfaithful, influenced by works like "The Da Vinci Code," identifying as an atheist and challenging my wife's Catholic faith. These misguided words led to personal struggles: grappling with anger, intolerance, difficulty in forgiveness, and entanglement in corporate politics. These battles left me ensnared in depression, devoid of peace....."
