
Apologies to a few people whom we missed last week.

SOCIAL JUSTICE



Catholic Influence in Society has waned over the decades, but we are still the largest church, largest faith group and largest non-profit organisation in the country, so we need to learn how to use our voices to better influence Australian society for good. *Our parish has joined The Sydney Alliance to help us do just that*. The Sydney Alliance brings together diverse community organisations, unions,

religious organisations and schools to advance the common good and achieve a fair, just and sustainable city. To achieve this, we provide opportunities for people to have a say in decisions that affect them, their families and everyone working and living in Sydney. The focus on recent years has been on affordable housing, improved public transport, support for refugees and affordable and clean energy.

The website **<u>www.sydneyalliance.org.au</u>** features photos and stories from a rally of 900 people held in February last year which Fr Jim and a number of parishioners attended.

At this rally the then treasurer Matt Kean and now treasurer Daniel Mookhey were pressed to make commitments in these areas. With incredible skill and passion the facilitators held our political leaders' feet to the fire and didn't let them get away with talking points and weasel words. It was just a few days later that both major parties announced new policies (as they were pressed to do by Sydney Alliance that night) to end 'no grounds' evictions during periodic tenancies so that renters won't fear an eviction for asking repairs.

This is the power of us as a church combining our voices with other groups who also want to work for the common good and a more just society.

Each year the Alliance offers a 2 day *Foundations Training* which is a course on how to organise communities, how to speak out on issues of justice, and how to speak to (and write to, and meet with) our elected leaders. Fr Jim did this course many years ago and parishioner Philip Vasallo did it last year and they both found it eye opening and transforming. As an Alliance member this training is free for members of our parish. Some parishioners have already signed up, and we'd love for more parishioners to do this.
