

Now, I believe it's time to take another counter-cultural step: to refrain from applause at the end of Mass. Applause is a natural response to performances, and the habit has been growing in churches. But Mass is not a performance - it's an act of worship, where we all participate fully and consciously. If we want to thank our musicians and ministers, the best way is to sing with full voice during Mass. By refraining from applause, we preserve the sacredness of the liturgy and help to mark out Mass as something quite unique in our culture.

Why I Became a Catechist

Last year, after attending Mass and hearing the call for catechists, I felt moved to help, though part of me hoped there were already enough volunteers. After all, I'm a pharmacist, not a teacher. But in my profession, I've seen

In a world where anxiety and depression are rising, faith can offer hope, resilience, and purpose. If we don't introduce children to God early, they may never explore faith later.

As a mum, I want my kids to know they're never alone—that with God, there is always light. Our faith teaches love, kindness, perseverance, and forgiveness—qualities that nurture both soul and wellbeing.

By becoming a catechist, we're not just teaching religion; we're planting seeds of hope. We're giving children the tools to face life's challenges with strength and grace. The diocese provides full support, the classes are well-organised, and the students are eager to learn.

As the saying goes, one hand doesn't clap by itself. We need to all join together and help our kids to get acquainted with our faith. If you have flexible hours and a heart for service, I encourage you to consider joining us. It might be the "preventative hope" our kids truly need and you might find your own faith deepened in the process.




YOUTH MINISTRIES

Reflection on the Minister of the Word Course – Australian Catholic University

I recently completed the Online Minister of the Word Course run by ACU, and it has been a wonderful experience. I wanted to do the course to serve my parish better and to help people understand the readings more clearly. Even though I was short on time, I persevered, and I'm glad I did because it helped me grow both in faith and in confidence.

The course reminded me that being a Minister of the Word is not about reading perfectly, but about letting God use us to share His message. I learned the importance of preparation, not just reading the Scripture beforehand but praying with it and letting it speak to my own heart first.

At first, speaking into a microphone was difficult, but with practice I grew more confident and learnt to trust that God would work through me. Spending more time with Scripture also brought me closer to God and reminded me that ministry is about being willing and faithful to serve.

I feel thankful for this opportunity and encourage anyone who has thought about becoming a Minister of the Word to give it a go, it is a beautiful way to serve God and our parish. 
