CATECHIST CORNER



Is your child attending a Public School in 2023? All NSW public schools are required to allow authorised churches and religious groups to teach special religious education for half an hour per week. Our generous volunteer catechists teach at 6 primary schools (Epping Heights, Epping North, Epping Public, Epping West, Roselea and Murray Farm) and 3 secondary schools (Carlingford High, Cheltenham Girls' and James Ruse Agriculture). Catechists from other parishes teach in schools elsewhere.

However these Scripture classes are an opt-in system, so **be** sure to notify your school office that your child is to attend **Catholic SRE**. They won't be missing out on any school subject, as a separate time slot is provided for SRE when other lessons aren't taking place.
