In the Acts of the Apostles this week and next we meet two unlikely disciples. Firstly Paul, the former persecutor of the Church (Acts 9), and then the pagan centurion Cornelius. In both cases people were at first sceptical of whether their new found faith in Jesus was real, but for each of them an existing disciple-Barnabas for Paul, Peter for Cornelius - took them under their wing and showed them how to live the Christian life. Pope Francis has shone the spotlight on this process and called it accompaniment and asked that everyone in the Church - priests, religious and laity - learn this art so that we may help others to hear the call of God in their lives and respond to it (Evangelii Gaudium 169-173).

We see this process at work in so many of our volunteer ministries, when we deliberately pair a new volunteer with an experienced one. An new catechist with an experienced one, an new altar server with someone who has served for decades, our new younger Cana youth group leaders with our youth minister Joanna, new Children's Liturgy leaders with long term volunteers. So trust, if you feel called to join a new ministry, that there will be someone there to be Barnabas for you, to help you and support you as you take up a new area of your Christian life. ~Fr Jim





This week we begin the Metanoia program which invites us to turn our hearts around and to go deeper with Jesus. It's not too late to join – come join us on Tuesday night, 7pm for dinner in the Parish Hall at St Gerard's.

We look forward to sharing the evening with you.

Thank you for your patience these past two weeks as not just the forecourt, but also the footpath in front of OLHC Church has been resurfaced. We apologise that this had blocked access to the toilets last weekend.

Saturday morning **8am Mass will recommence Saturday May 4th** and Tuesday night **6pm Mass will recommence on Tuesday May 7th.**

Mass counts: During each week of May every parish in Australia counts the number of people at Mass which gives us both a snapshot about how many people are at each Mass that month, and the longer term trend over several years. This data has told us a good news story these past few years, with Mass attendance rising from 755 in 2021, to 830 in 2022 and 1005 in 2023. We are inching toward the pre-covid level of 1147 in 2019, and perhaps we'll get back there this year. To measure this, we need some volunteers to do the count during Mass at St Gerard's (OLHC is already sorted). Please put your name on the list in the sacristy if you can help count for the four weeks of May. We'll need four volunteers per Mass.

Hospital Chaplaincy and Pastoral Care

On May 4th & 5th we are taking up one of our two annual Pastoral Works Fund appeal collections for the diocese.

This primarily funds the resourcing of our catechists and Catholic hospital chaplaincy (including Fr Peter Dowd at Royal North Shore Hospital).

Our levy for this financial year is \$54,000, of which you generously gave \$29,000 in the November appeal. The remaining \$25,000 equates to \$25 for each of our 1000 parishioners. Not everyone can

afford this (and lots of our 1000 parishioners are children), so your donation of \$25 or more (which is tax deductible) would be a great gift both from you but also on behalf of others who cannot afford it.

You can give using the Good Giving app via this QR code which will send you a tax receipt immediately, or, using the envelopes which you'll find on your seats, and the parish will provide a tax receipt in July. You can also take an envelope from the back of the church this weekend.



FIAT 40 testimony

For Lent this year, a group of young men and women participated in the Exodus 40 and Fiat 40 (respectively). These programs involved multiple changes in our daily lifestyles that aimed to remove obstacles that separate us from God.

Habits that were given up or decreased included time spent on social media and TV, no major purchases and no desserts or sweets. It also involved increased daily prayer time, evening reflections, daily Gospel readings and regular physical activity. Each group would touch base with its members to support and encourage each other and share their struggles with any particular habits.

One thing that surprised me was how it was relatively easier to 'tick the boxes' (like not using technology) as opposed to sitting still for twenty minutes and actively dedicated a longer period of time each day to spend time with God. However, this was also the most rewarding in listening to God. I found that doing so changed my outlook on each day. We all grew closer to God through these small changes with some striving to continue these habits after Easter!


