Access via the carpark or Oxford St. Dinner will be prepared by our parish volunteers and food will be labelled so people with food allergies can choose what is best for them.



SOME REFLECTIONS FROM PARISH LAUDATO SI' READING GROUPS


...for me as a Christian, the document helps me to connect my faith and ecology.




