Holy Week & Easter Preparations

Easter is early this year! Here are the times for each of our Masses and liturgies which will be the same in both churches:

• Holy Thursday March 28th 7.30pm

Good Friday Stations 10am Good Friday Passion 3pm

• Easter Vigil 7pm

• Easter Sunday follows the usual Sunday times, except, there will be no 5pm Sunday night Mass at St Gerard's on March 31st.

Palms for Palm Sunday: Once again we are relying on your generosity to provide palms for the parish to use on Palm Sunday March 24th. We don't need large palms (contact the parish office directly if you have these), but smaller ones which can be cut into pieces for individual use. Please bring them to the church on *Saturday March 23rd*.

Footwashing: Jesus said at the Last Supper "Unless I wash your feet you can have no part with me". Would you be willing to have your feet washed at the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday night? Put your name on the list at the back of the church.



The Chrism Mass will be celebrated at 7.30pm on Tuesday, 26 March at Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral, Waitara. The priests of our Diocese gather for this celebration with Bishop Anthony Randazzo to renew their priestly commitment. During Mass, the oils of Catechumens and the Sick are

blessed, and the Chrism is consecrated and then taken back to each parish for use in various Sacramental liturgies throughout the year. All parishioners are warmly invited to attend this sacred occasion in the life of our Diocese.

Ecumenical: Some people have asked about our annual ecumenical gatherings during Lent. Last year we realised that with changes to the clergy at our local covenant churches (St Alban's Anglican, Epping Uniting and West Epping Uniting) that we couldn't continue to have as many stand-alone liturgies which relied on the ordained ministers. Instead, we would have at least one liturgy, which this year will be at St Alban's on Tues May 14th for Pentecost, and focus rather on other shared events. Last year these included prayer for Gaza on the forecourt of OLHC, and a forum on The Voice at Epping Uniting Church. This year we will have a Palm Sunday procession between St Alban's, OLHC and Epping Uniting, time TBC.

PARISH NEWS & UPDATES



Deacon Richard Houwing, our Business Manager, updates:

Roof repair St Gerard's Church: For some time now, we have had water leakage through the roof area around the skylight at St Gerard's Church. Over time the sealants around the windows and flashing at the base and on the roof have deteriorated, requiring complete replacements. This work was carried out earlier this month, resulting in no leaks and protection of the woodwork from water damage and rot.

Repairs to St Gerard's Parish Hall: A little while back, we won a NSW Government grant to repair and renovate the Parish Hall. During March, we will be repairing the roof from broken tiles and repointing the capping and eaves. We will also install safe access points for workers for air-conditioner maintenance and other roof access. As a precautionary measure for children and all, fencing will be installed around the Hall while works are carried out. The Hall will remain available, access will be limited to the front door, but fire egress remains as previously.



Palliative Care Petition: As Catholics we maintain our opposition to euthanasia, which has now become legal in NSW. A good alternative though for people who are dying is palliative care, which we do support as Catholics. Palliative care means the withdrawing of medical treatment to extend life, and instead offering comfort care including pain relief. This may be offered at home or in hospital, and many parishioners have experienced the wonderful care which palliative care teams have offered their loved ones at the end of their lives.

The 2022-23 State Budget allocated an additional \$743.4 million over the five years to 2026-27 to enhance palliative care for people across New South Wales through improved other symptom management options. Unfortunately \$150 million of which was cut in the 2023-24 Budget.

A petition has been set up in which the petitioners led by Hon Susan Carter MLC request that the House notes that this cut will mean that some people in New South Wales will not receive palliative care, and calls on the NSW Government to reverse this cut and fully restore the \$743.4 million in additional funding for enhanced palliative care services throughout New South Wales.






