Metanoia: Every Catholic, no matter where we are in our faith journey, is invited to a deeper conversion (metanoia). Metanoia is not a once-only event; rather, it is a continual process of turning away from the things of the world, from lies and sin and discovering a deeper union with Christ.

We invite you to join us for a video series called *Metanoia* which will challenge us to go deeper with Jesus. We'll run it in the same format as our other popular programs such as Alpha where we meet to share dinner, then watch the video, then share our response in small groups.

Metanoia is presented by Fr Dave Pivonka who presented the wonderful Wild Goose series which we watched together last year. The series is beautifully filmed on location in the Holy Land, highlighting sacred places such as the Sea of Galilee, the River Jordan, the

desert of Temptations, and many of the holy sites in Jerusalem. Each episode explores areas of our life where conversion is so often necessary.

Metanoia will examine topics such as who is Jesus, what must we do to inherit eternal life, and many other significant matters of faith. With preaching from Fr. Dave as well as personal testimonies from men and women, young and old, religious and lay, their stories will inspire you to seek to encounter Jesus and the new life he is constantly inviting us to.




