Community Dinners

Mother Teresa said that the greatest poverty is loneliness. We now know that loneliness causes ill health both physically and mentally, and that this is on the rise. How many people in our area are lonely? Perhaps they have family, but see them rarely. Perhaps they are new migrants. Perhaps they struggle to make friends. How many people can afford food, but eat every meal alone? Let alone those who now struggle financially, for whom a free meal might make a difference.

What can we as a parish do? We propose to start "Community Dinners", a free, open weekly meal for anyone who wants to share a meal in company, both parishioners and non-parishioners alike. OLHC Epping is the ideal location given the accessibility of the new hall from the street. We will create community, motivated by the love and example of Jesus who shared meals with both his close friends and society's outcasts. We will serve people not because they are Catholic, but because we are.

To do this we need to create 4 teams of volunteers who will each cook and serve one week each month. A mix of skills will be needed: cooks, servers, people who can move furniture to set and pack up, and people with the "people skills" to greet guests and to sit with them as necessary to build community at the tables.

Pastoral Works Fund Appeal: This month we are taking up one of our two annual Pastoral Works Fund appeal collections for the diocese. This primarily funds the resourcing of our catechists and Catholic hospital chaplaincy (including Fr Peter Dowd at Royal North Shore Hospital).

Our levy for this financial year is \$52,000, of which you generously gave \$25,000 in the November appeal. The remaining \$27,000 equates to around \$25 for each of our 1120 parishioners. Not everyone can afford this (and lots of our 1120 parishioners are children), so your donation of \$25 or more (which is tax deductible) would be a great gift both from you but also on behalf of others who cannot afford it.


