

FIRST RECONCILIATION 2023

As First Reconciliation enrolment closes, Parent Information Sessions will be held on the evenings of 7th and 9th February on Zoom. We always look forward to sharing these sessions with parents. The sessions encompass aspects of First Reconciliation which are important to assist parents in the understanding of their child's faith journey and their partnership with the parish. We have continued having our gatherings on Zoom thanks to the wonderful feedback from parents. They found themselves more able to relax in the comfort of home rather than having to rush somewhere after a long day, amongst other reasons.

At select Masses the following weekend of the 11th & 12 February, we welcome the children who will begin their preparations towards the reception of their First Reconciliation. This Rite of Enrolment marks the continuation of a faith journey for the children who received the Sacrament of Confirmation in September last year or for some, at Baptism. This journey in particular also highlights the continuous companionship of their parents in teaching the children about the Catholic faith and the vital role we as a community play in ensuring our ongoing support of prayers and encouragement for them.

This is an opportunity for us to show these families they are not alone in this journey; we are accompanying them! The families will also be presented with their Reconciliation preparation materials during this Rite, which confirms their enrolment and commitment to this special journey.

Our monthly **Family Kidz Masses** are on the third Sunday of every month during school term at both churches. At OLHC, this has now **changed to the 8:30am Mass** and at St Gerard's this remains at 9:30am.

The children provide the ministries such as being part of the choir, lead in the prayers of the faithful and the penitential rite, in entrance, gospel and offertory processions.

The next Kidz Mass is on the **19th February**. Fr Jim and Fr Aldrin invite children from **Year 6 to kickstart the first Kidz Mass of the year!** There will also be a special blessing for the new Kindy families from both parish schools. We look forward to seeing you there.

PARISH SOCIAL JUSTICE TEAM

JRS Australia extends warm congratulations to our Board member, Muzafar Ali, who has been honoured with the 2022 Humanitarian of the Year Award from the Fred Hollows Foundation for his work in establishing and supporting refugee-led educational facilities for refugees in Indonesia and advocating for durable solutions to be made available for them.

Muzafar Ali, himself a former refugee who resettled to Australia from Indonesia, joined the JRS Australia Board in 2021. He is a member of the Hazara community from Afghanistan and helped set up the Cisarua Refugee Learning Centre (CRLC) to educate the children of refugees who have limited opportunities for an education in Indonesia. Over the years, CRLC has successfully trained students who have graduated to teach at the CRLC and even obtain scholarships elsewhere. See

The Australian government announced in November 2014 that refugees in Indonesia

who registered with UNHCR after 1 July that year will not be resettled to Australia. Now numbering over 13,000 people, this population has been devastatingly affected by the years of uncertainty about their future and lost opportunities which have resulted. Muzafar's passionate advocacy on their behalf has strengthened JRS Australia's efforts to seek a repeal of this cruel policy.

In reversing this policy, Australia would also address what is fast becoming a protracted refugee situation. Australia should also resume the processing of applications for humanitarian protection that were registered in Indonesia before July 2014 but the processing of which stopped during the COVID-19 pandemic.
