Easter is the celebration of the death and resurrection of Jesus, which is the central event of human history. Join us for the three liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter at both churches:

 Good Friday Stations 10am

 Good Friday Passion 3pm

 Easter Vigil 7pm

Please note that these are long and solemn services which are important for adults, but not so suitable for very young children. The more family-friendly service will be the Good Friday Stations at 10am at St Gerard's which will again be an outdoor procession, starting at the hall and making our way up to the church.

We also celebrate the Office of Readings and RCIA preparatory rites, a short, stark service of psalms and reflection on Holy Saturday 10am at OLHC. Please note there is no 8am morning Mass at OLHC on Holy Saturday.




