Reminder!

Volunteers Thank-You Evening: Our annual celebration of our volunteers will be on Tuesday Feb 13th with Mass at 7pm and dinner at 7.45pm at St Gerard's. An invitation for each volunteer will be available at the back of the church for you on the weekend of Jan 13th.

REMEMBER! → Changes to OLHC times in January: As mentioned earlier, during January the forecourt of OLHC Church will be relevelled and resurfaced as part of the redevelopment. This will make the church inaccessible on weekdays, including Saturday mornings. **From Tuesday Jan 2nd to Saturday 27th** the church will not be open on weekdays, and there will not be Mass and Adoration on Tuesday evenings or Saturday mornings. **Reconciliation will instead be available from 4.15pm – 4.45pm on Saturdays in January.** We apologise for this inconvenience. The builders will reinstate the access ramp to the front and side doors for weekends, so **all weekend Masses (including the vigil Mass) will continue as usual.**

Weekday Masses continue at St Gerard's as usual, and the church will continue to be open for prayer.
