

The Parish Team wishes all a beautiful day of celebrating fathers on this Sunday. Cheers to all the love, the funnies, the struggles and the memories! A special prayer for all in fatherly roles and also for those who are missing a loved one.

**Encountering Jesus Christ in the Eucharist** is the title of a new pastoral letter by Bishop Anthony. Bishop Anthony wants to prepare us to receive Communion from the chalice once again, to point the way to the 2028 Eucharistic Congress, and to enhance our experience of the Eucharist here and now. Please pick up your copy from the back of the church.



**Giving:** Our parish relies on your generosity to keep our ministries running - from lighting our churches for prayer, to providing communion hosts and altar candles, morning teas, staff wages, and programs for children, youth, adults, and outreach.

Typically, long-time parishioners are our most committed givers, while newer members often wait to be invited. So over the next two weeks, I'll be asking you to consider becoming a regular giver, according to your means. If you've made this parish your spiritual home, I invite you to express that commitment through regular giving. Every amount, given consistently, makes a difference and shows your support for God's work here.

Applause: We've been encouraging parents to see their child's participation in liturgy not as a photo moment, but as something sacred, and we're seeing growing reverence at First Communions, Confirmations, and school Masses. Now, I believe it's time to take another counter-cultural step: to refrain from applause at the end of Mass. Applause is a natural response to performances, and the habit has been growing in churches. But Mass is not a performance - it's an act of worship, where we all participate fully and consciously. If we want to thank our musicians and ministers, the best way is to sing with full voice during Mass. By refraining from applause, we preserve the sacredness of the liturgy and help to mark out Mass as something quite unique in our culture.

The Season of Creation App was developed by Queensland Churches Environmental Network.


The App contains a reflection, prayer and verse for each day of the Season of Creation. Each reflection is illustrated by beautiful photographs of Australian landscape flora and fauna.




