- **Oct 22nd** we are inviting children who attend Catholic Scripture in our six local state schools to take part in a special SRE Mass at 9:30am.
- **Oct 29th** (9:30am & 10:15am) we're celebrating All Saints as an alternative to Halloween with special "dress as your favourite saint" events at both churches. And so much more!

November celebrations

All Saints Day is Wednesday November 1st. We'll celebrate this with:

- a vigil Mass on Tuesday Oct 31st at 6pm at OLHC,
- morning Mass on Wednesday Nov 1st at 9:30am at St Gerard's.



All Souls Day on **Thursday Nov 2nd** begins our month of remembering those who have died. We will have Masses at **St Gerard's at 9:30am** and **at OLHC at 7pm**. You may like to bring a photo to place in front of the altar to represent the person you love. There will also be Mass at **North Rocks Catholic Cemetery at 4pm** followed by the blessing of graves.

On **Sunday November 5th** our parish will have a liturgy at **Macquarie Park Cemetery at the Ascension Hill gazebo from 11.30am** followed by a shared lunch together. This will be an opportunity to pray at the grave of people we love who have died, and to find support in one another.

Book of Remembrance: The book of remembrance will be placed on or near the altar for each Mass during November. It is at the back of the church for you to add the names of people you love who have died.



Hien's Ordination: Many of you will remember seminarian Hien Vu who spent 2021 with us on his pastoral placement and has continued to be a friend of the parish. His ordination to Diaconate will be on Friday Nov 24th, 7:30pm at St Leonard's Church, Naremburn. We are considering taking a bus across to the ordination to save everyone having to drive. If you're interested in **a seat on the bus** for a small cost (\$20 for adults and \$10 for children) **please put your name on the list at the back of the church before Oct 23rd.**

OLHC NEWS & UPDATES

Weekday Mass at OLHC continues to be difficult with construction noise. Construction is now going past 5pm, making our Wednesday evening 5pm Mass quite noisy. There seems to be agreement that moving Mass later to 6pm might make it accessible for more people as well as avoiding the noise. We'll also take this opportunity to **move Mass and adoration to Tuesdays**, so that there is now a Mass on Tuesdays which we've not had all year. So **starting Tuesday October 17th we'll have Adoration and Reconciliation available from 5pm followed by Mass at 6pm every Tuesday night**, in place of Wednesday nights.

Junior Altar Servers at OLHC: OLHC has some dedicated young people who are junior altar servers. The problem is, they are growing up and some are now adult servers! We'd like to invite young people who have received Holy Communion and who are in Year 4 or older to become junior altar servers at OLHC (a separate invitation for St Gerard's will come later). There will be two training sessions each lasting 45 min – 1 hour:



- **Session 1** on Sat Oct 28 at 4pm or Sunday Oct 29th at 11:15am, and
- **Session 2** on Sat Nov 11th at 4pm or Sunday Nov 19th at 11:15am.

OTHER PARISH NEWS & UPDATES

Retreat Day for Altar Servers and Communion Ministers: An initiative of the Parish Pastoral Council this year was to provide ongoing formation for people doing liturgical ministries. After very enjoyable retreat days for our Music Ministers and Ministers of the Word, our next retreat and formation day will be for Senior Altar Servers and for Ministers of the Word on **Saturday November 18th at St Benedict's Monastery, Arcadia**. Invitations are available in the sacristy of each church. Planning is underway for retreats next year for those who serve in ministries of hospitality and other ministries.



Christmas Mass times: For those of you who like to plan ahead we have confirmed our Christmas Mass times:

- At OLHC: Dec 24th - 5pm vigil and 9pm vigil. Dec 25th - 8.30am and 10.15am.
- At St Gerard's: Dec 24th - 6pm vigil and 10pm vigil. Dec 25th - 7.45am and 9.30am.

Cypress removal: A little while back a qualified independent arborist inspected all the trees in our precinct and identified several trees that presented a risk. One of these was the large Cypressus Torulosa (Italian Cypress) and it needed to be removed as it has shifted in the ground in recent storms. This species do fail often in such circumstances and the arborist had doubts whether the tree's root system could continue to manage the load of the tree. We had the overall situation verified by another arborist. This tree was located adjacent the footpath to the school.

Cracks and lifting in the ground were already apparent. For the protection of parishioners and school children this tree was removed and will be replaced by a range of suitable shrubs and trees including Australian natives. Inspection of the various trunks upon demolition confirmed that rot had commenced.

World Youth Day Testimony Corner

Alex de Lima Reflects

2 months ago, I was fortunate enough to attend World Youth Day 2023 in Lisbon with over 150 other young people from the Broken Bay Diocese.

Our journey began with an eye-opening pilgrimage through Italy. We visited astounding churches, experienced historic and sacred sites, deepened our knowledge of the faith, and grew closer to each other. We then arrived in Portugal where we gathered with over a million Catholics from around the world. Our week in Lisbon was spent meeting other youths, gathering in large Catechesis sessions, celebrating Mass, praying together and habitually repeating Oi, Oi, Oi many, many times.

What amazed me the most was the fact that despite speaking different languages, coming from various backgrounds and simply never having seen each other before, no one was a stranger. We were all united through Christ. It was truly an unforgettable experience, one that transformed my perception of faith and my relationship with God.

Over the three weeks that I spent following in the footsteps of the Saints and praying with inconceivable masses of people, I became aware of the vastness of the Catholic faith. It is connected across 20 centuries, 7 continents and amongst billions of people. I realised that our faith is not reducible to the relationship between an individual and their God; rather it is a relationship that grows and extends, in the love people show to each other.

This idea was summarised by the American Cardinal Sean O'Malley as he beckoned us to 'Make a gift of ourselves for God and for others.' He reminded me that no one is simply a body, or a mind, or a personality type or even a human being. *Each of us is a gift.*

Together with the Pope's calling, 'Do not be afraid!', I was reminded of how I can share the Catholic faith and spread the good news. I hope to continue to do so here in my own parish as well as the wider community.

Finally, I want to extend a huge thank you to all parishioners from the Epping and Carlingford community for being so generous and supportive of the young people who attended World Youth Day 2023.
