Changes to OLHC Weekday Masses

Even before the disruptions of lockdowns and redevelopment, OLHC Epping has had relatively low numbers of people at weekday Masses. In 2022 when we could no longer have 12.15pm Mass due to demolition noise we trialled a 6pm Mass at Wednesday night, hoping that this might work for commuters returning home, but we have rarely had more than a dozen people. In 2023 we will trial some Mass times with a view to ascertaining what might be of service to our people, without duplicating the times of our nearest neighbours. From Jan 2nd we have moved the Monday night Adoration & Reconciliation to Wednesday nights from 5.30pm – 6.30pm. To accommodate this we will have Wednesday night Mass at 5pm rather than 6pm. From Feb 21st we will have 9am Mass on Tuesdays, 5pm Mass on Wednesdays, and 12pm Mass on Thursdays.


Why these changes? Monday nights, while popular for adoration and reconciliation, are always going to be irregular as it is usually one of the priest's day off, and gets cancelled whenever the other priest is on holidays or away. Tuesday 9am Mass gives the parish a daily Tuesday Mass again and also makes room for the monthly healing masses and nursing home masses, even when one priest is away. Thursday 12pm restores what had been OLHC's weekday Mass time. Let's trial these times for a few months and see what works best. In 2024 when we move the school, parish offices, and then presbytery back on site we will be in a better position establish permanent weekday Masses at OLHC.

Generosity: Thank you for the extraordinary generosity which parishioners have shown in recent weeks. The St Vincent de Paul Christmas appeal at OLHC and St Gerards raised much needed funds, in addition to Christmas hampers. Going further back in the year, \$8,870 was given to the Catholic Care Homelessness Appeal in August, which was the largest amount in any parish of our diocese.

The Parish Finance Committee (PFC) farewells *Pat McArdle* and *Ram Sharma* from its membership this year. We thank them for their assistance with the financial and material governance of the parish.
