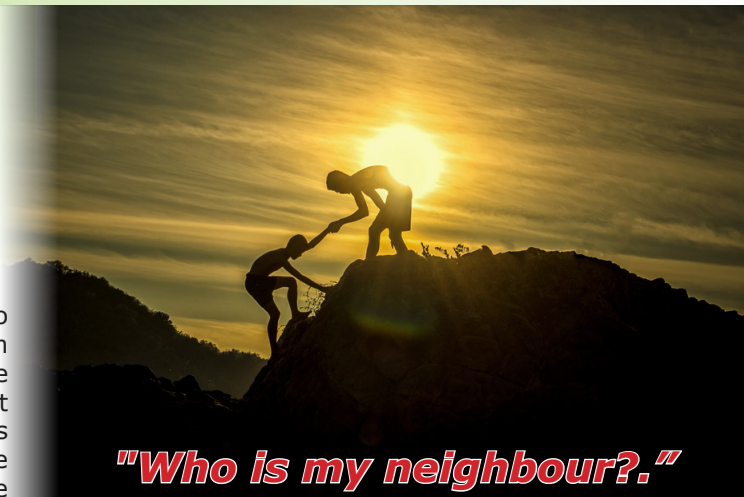


LETTER FROM FR GREG

Dear parishioners,

We are beginning a new financial year. I would like to take this opportunity to express how truly grateful I am for all of your contributions over the last year. Because of you, our parish was not only able to pay our bills but also undertake many evangelisation projects, renovations and improvements both in our church and around the property. Also, our parish raised the full amount for the PWBB quote that was asked of us, and then some! You are very caring and generous, and I would like to say a huge THANK YOU to each and every one of you!

The beginning of the new financial year is also an opportunity to renew or join planned giving and direct debit commitments, your promise of financial support to our parish once again for the year 2022-2023. These commitments are always a huge help to us as they allow us to accurately budget for the whole year. Colleen, our parish secretary, and I are always searching for new financial opportunities to cover the costs of different projects and apply for funding from the government where appropriate. However, we still need your help and would be very grateful for your ongoing contributions which will



assure us that we can cover all our expenses in the future. There are many things that need to be done this year and here are just a few examples:

- ✦ Replacement of all of the doors in the church, which are in very bad condition and slowly falling apart. For this project we were fortunate to receive money from the government.
- ✦ There are some significant costs to be covered in regards to the installation of the relic of JP II, which is a great opportunity and investment for our parish community to grow and evangelise others even more.
- ✦ We are in the process of renewing the sound system in the church which is currently in a very bad condition.
- ✦ Some work needs to be done on the entrance to the church from Victoria street in order to ensure safe wheelchair access.
- ✦ Our annual insurance for all of the properties is around \$31,000pa.

The list is very long and very expensive. I am very aware that the cost of living is particularly high at the moment, which is why I truly appreciate every dollar that you are able to donate to our parish.

Let us continue to keep our parish alive, welcoming, caring and vibrant so that all people who come here can have opportunities to know and love Jesus Christ our Saviour.

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A PARISH, A CATHEDRAL, A BASILICA, & A SHRINE



PARISH

"A parish is a definite community of the Christian faithful established on a stable basis within a particular church; the pastoral care of the parish is entrusted to a pastor as its own shepherd under the authority of the diocesan bishop."



CATHEDRAL

A cathedral is the chief church of a diocese and in itself is also a parish church. The bishop is technically the pastor of the cathedral parish, and appoints a rector to manage its spiritual and temporal affairs



BASILICA

The term basilica was used to identify churches of historic and spiritual importance. Usually, these churches are built in the basilica style, but the key criterion is that they are places of historic and spiritual importance.



SHRINE

A shrine is a church or other sacred place where a relic is preserved, or where an apparition has taken place, it may also be an historical event of faith has taken place. Lastly, a shrine may also be a place designated to foster a belief or devotion

He replied, 'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbour as yourself.' 'You have answered right,' said Jesus, 'do this and life is yours.'

But the man was anxious to justify himself and said to Jesus, 'And who is my neighbour?' Jesus replied, 'A man was once on his way down from Jerusalem to Jericho and fell into the hands of brigands; they took all he had, beat him and then made off, leaving him half dead. Now a priest happened to be travelling down the same road, but when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. In the same way a Levite who came to the place saw him, and passed by on the other side. But a Samaritan traveller who came upon him was moved with compassion when he saw

him. He went up and bandaged his wounds, pouring oil and wine on them. He then lifted him on to his own mount, carried him to the inn and looked after him. Next day, he took out two denarii and handed them to the innkeeper. "Look after him," he said, "and on my way back I will make good any extra expense you have." Which of these three, do you think, proved himself a neighbour to the man who fell into the brigands' hands?' 'The one who took pity on him,' he replied. Jesus said to him, 'Go and do the same yourself.'

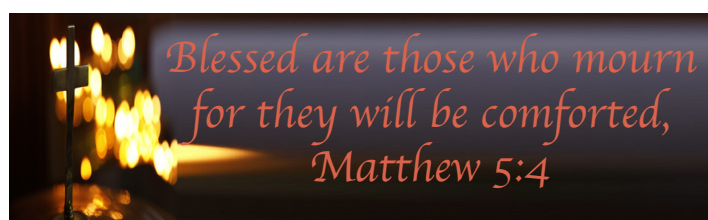
