REFLECTION

BY OUR SEMINARIAN, HUY TRAN

"Natural things have a natural inclination not only towards their own proper good, to acquire it if not possessed, and, if possessed, to rest therein; but also, to spread abroad their own good amongst others, so far as possible."

Since God is the goodness itself, it is much more appropriate for God to communicate his goodness to others, hence he creates everything including us out of his goodness and love. Also, out of his great infinite goodness and love, he comes so close to us as a little baby in a manger to share every aspect of human life.

As Advent season is coming to an end and Christmas is just around the corner, the Church invites us to celebrate the great joy for the goodness of our God with the third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete (Rejoice) Sunday. The Church communicates a great news for us: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near." (Phil 4:4-5). Prophet Isaiah, upon receiving the great goodness of God, could not contain it but burst forth for the people of Israel: "[The Lord] has sent me to bring good news to the poor; to bind of hearts that are broken; to proclaim liberty to captives, freedom to those in those in prison; to proclaim a year of favour from the Lord." (Isaiah 61:1-2). This verse from Isaiah would later be quoted by Jesus himself. Finally, when John the Baptist knowing that Jesus is the goodness itself incarnated, John cannot not preach about Jesus to all those who were around him: "there stands among you – unknown to you - the one who is coming after me; and I am not fit to undo his sandal-strap" (John 1:27). John the Baptist had all the reasons to accept people's praises, but he refused and pointed to the right one, the Messiah, Jesus Christ.

Since we are all created in the Image of God (Imago Dei), in our nature, we also want to communicate our goodness and the goodness that we possess to other people. Gaudente Sunday invites us to all communicate the greatest news for other people: God is Emmanuel, God is here with us, God is here for us, God is here about us, so close that one can touch him, see him and hear his voice. Are we courageous enough to talk about God to others, to share his message of love, joy and peace to others and to



Now these men had been sent by the Pharisees, and they put this further question to him, 'Why are you baptising if you are not the Christ, and not Elijah, and not the prophet?' John replied, 'I baptise with water; but there stands among you unknown to you - the one who is coming after me; and I am not fit to undo his sandal-strap.' This happened at Bethany, on the far side of the Jordan, where John was baptising.


