" Brothers, sisters...

I speak to you, especially to those who no longer believe, no longer hope, no longer pray, because they think God has left.

To those who are fed up with scandals, with misused power, with the silence of a Church that sometimes seems more like a palace than a home.

THE COAT OF ARMS OF LEO XIV

Silver mitre with three gold bands:

These bands represent the powers of order, jurisdiction, and magisterium, united at the center to signify their unity in one person.

White lily on a blue background:

A flower and color traditionally associated with the Virgin Mary, emphasizing her central role in the Church's journey. Mary is a model of listening, humility, and total self-gift to God. The lily also symbolizes purity and innocence.



Motto

These words were spoken by St. Augustine in a sermon (Exposition on Psalm 127) to explain that "although we Christians are many, in the one Christ we are one."

Order of St. Augustine:

A closed book with a heart pierced by an arrow, symbolizing St. Augustine's conversion. It recalls his words: "You pierced my heart with Your Word" (Vulnerasti cor meum verbo tuo).

The keys:

The keys represent the temporal (silver) and spiritual (gold) power of the papacy, referring to the passage in Matthew 16:18-19.

CARITAS AUSTRALIA AND CATHOLIC RELIGIOUS AUSTRALIA CALL FOR AN END TO HUMAN SUFFERING IN GAZA

Caritas Australia and Catholic Religious Australia (CRA) affirms its call for unimpeded humanitarian aid access, an end to the suffering of civilians in Gaza, and, in accord with the recent call for peace and the provision of humanitarian aid in Gaza made in the first Sunday blessing of His Holiness Pope Leo XIV. Over the last two months of near-total aid blockade, only 14 out of 63 recent aid missions were successfully completed without being withdrawn, denied, or impeded. International humanitarian law forbids the denial of aid as a tool of war, while also prohibiting the forced displacement of civilians.
