The missionary call is a call to love, to reach out, and to serve. As Pope Francis said:


"Each of us is a mission to this world, for each of us is the fruit of God's love."



The boat symbolizes both the perilous journeys of migrants and the Church, the Barque of Peter. As the Cross travels across Australia, it invites us to welcome all as brothers and sisters, seeing in their stories the richness of faith, culture, and hope.


