REFLECTION ON THE MONTH OF OCTOBER DEDICATED TO THE HOLY ROSARY

October is a special month in the Catholic Church, dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary—a powerful and cherished prayer that leads us into a deeper relationship with Jesus through the intercession of His Blessed Mother, Mary. As we journey through October, we are invited to renew our devotion to the Rosary and reflect on the mysteries of Christ's life, death, and resurrection with heartfelt reverence and faith.

The importance of reciting the Holy Rosary cannot be overstated. It is a spiritual weapon, a source of peace, and a means of grace. Pope St. John Paul II once called the Rosary "a compendium of the Gospel," as each decade leads us to contemplate a vital moment in the life of Jesus and Mary. Through this meditative prayer, we are drawn closer to the heart of our faith. pray the Rosary together as a community. This simple yet profound act of prayer brings us together in unity and strengthens the spiritual bonds within our parish. Whether you are new to the Rosary or have prayed it for many years, your presence and prayers are a valuable offering to Our Lady and to the Church.

Finally, we encourage all parishioners to attend the last Fatima Night for this year, which will be held on Saturday 11 October at 5:00 PM. This special evening includes the Mass, Rosary and a candlelight procession in honor of Our Lady of Fatima. It is a beautiful way to conclude our October devotions and renew our commitment to prayer and peace in the world.

As we continue through this month of the Holy Rosary, let us entrust ourselves and our loved ones to the loving care of the Blessed Virgin Mary. May her intercession lead us closer to Jesus and bring lasting peace to our hearts and our world.

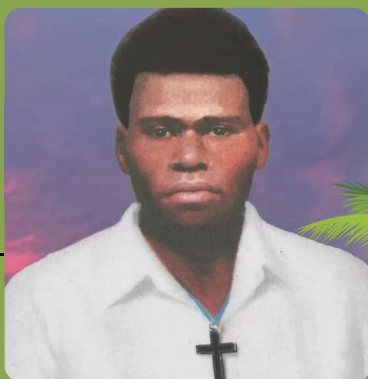

JUBILEE OF THE MISSIONS 4-5 OCTOBER

A year of Jubilee is a year of hope and liberation. A time to rest, return to your roots, and refresh. A time for societies and peoples to be liberated from what holds them back from living a full life. Traditionally it was a call for debts to be forgiven, and structures reformed so that all could live in dignity and social equity. Jesus likened his mission, his purpose to a Jubilee Year when he declared: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, for he has anointed me. "He has sent me to bring good news to the poor, to proclaim liberty to captives, new sight to the blind and freedom to prisoners. To announce a year of favour from the Lord," (Luke 4:18-19).

JUBILEE OF MIGRANTS 4-5 OCTOBER

The Jubilee of Migrants acknowledges and celebrates the gifts, contributions, and resilience that migrant communities bring to our Church and the world. It is also an opportunity to highlight the image of the Church as a place of refuge, welcome, integration, and solidarity. "History teaches us that the contribution of migrants and refugees has been fundamental to the social and economic growth of our societies. This continues to be true in our own day. Their work, their youth, their enthusiasm and their willingness to sacrifice enrich the communities that receive them."

A reading from the prophet Habakkuk

Keep as your pattern the sound teaching you have heard from me, in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. You have been trusted to look after something precious; guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us.
