Promise of a new Life

My dear Parishioners

Easter greetings to you and your families, and extended ones too!

The joyful message of Easter is that we are a "Resurrection people". This means that we are not supposed to lie buried in our very own selves. Instead, we are expected to live a joyful life, constantly experiencing the living presence of the Risen Lord in all our day-to-day life. Our awareness of the all-pervading presence of the Risen Lord in and around us and our neighbours is a strong conviction of our own resurrection.

Pope Francis says: "We are called to be people of joyful hope, not prophets of doom. Through the resurrection of Jesus, we get an infusion of hope and joy, and an invitation to share them by our way of living."

The Easter event, which is the Resurrection of His Son Jesus Christ, convinces us that God is at work in the world. We need to discern where God is moving in our lives and during the current pandemic to bring healing to the vulnerable, preventing of future illness, and join God's arc of spirituality and healing.

May the Risen Lord be a living experience to you, pervading every area of your life, blessing you, strengthening you, inspiring you, guiding you and supporting you and all of us on our journey of faith.
