

Pope Francis' Prayer Intention for August: The Maritime World: We pray for all those who work and live from the sea, among them sailors, fishermen and their families.

My dear Parishioners,

The weekend's Responsorial Psalm (Ps 145), to which we will repeat...

"The Hand of the Lord feeds us; He answers all our needs," in praise of the maternal care of a loving and providing God. In the Gospel of Mathew (Mt 14:13-21), Jesus demonstrates God's caring love for us by feeding the people, spiritually by his preaching and physically by the miraculous multiplication of five loaves and two fish. This miracle invites us to reflect on the Divinity of Jesus, in God the Father, and the compassion of Jesus for the crowd, and beyond that what have we brought from our persons to be multiple and shared. It is also a Messianic sign, presenting Jesus as the new Moses who fed the Israelites in the desert and the new Elisha who miraculously fed the starving people of Gilgal (2 Kings 42-44). The Eucharistic wordings used, "He raised his eyes to heaven and said the blessing and breaking the loaves, He handed them to His disciples." The miracle a prefiguring symbol of The Eucharist. Our



discipleship is about witnessing, and in the witnessing is the invitation to *"go and do likewise"*. *It is a call to do as Jesus would do.*
