## Sunday Reflection

My dear Parishioners,

The first reading shows us how God saved the life of Abraham's son Isaac as a reward for Abraham's trusting Faith. Because of this Faith, the Lord renewed His promise to Abraham for the blessings of land and progeny.

The Gospel highlights Jesus' identity as God's beloved Son (revealed at His baptism and Transfiguration) and confront us with the mystery of His death on the cross. While Abraham's son Isaac was spared, God's beloved Son, Jesus, died a cruel death on the cross.

Both these journeys of Faith emphasise God's infinite love, as seen in the redemptive sacrifice of His own Son for the salvation of the world.

That is why St. Paul reminds us, of God's willingness to sacrifice His Own Son as proof of His great love for humankind. Describing Jesus' transfiguration, the Gospel shows us a glimpse of the Heavenly glory awaiting those who do God's will by putting their trusting Faith in Him.

To conclude: "the freedom of let Go" is an invitation we are all called to embrace and encounter. Peter and the others had to let go of this precious experience; For now, their task was to listen to Jesus, 'This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him'. That is our task too. We spend our lives listening to the Lord as he speaks to us in His word and in and through the circumstances of our lives; we listen to Him as a preparation for that wonderful moment when we see Him face to face in eternity and we can finally say, 'it is wonderful to be here'.

May the Lord continue to bless us on this journey of faith.
