# SUNDAY REFLECTION by Fr Manoj Manuel

An experience of my life popped up in my mind as I read the Gospel reading to write this reflection. Let me share it here in short.

In my first year of seminary, there was an unexpected and sudden earth quake that was strong, as well as it sent out a few after shocks that made it to last for a good period of time. The building we were in shook violently and the fear doubled with rattling windows and doors. We ran out into the open air, and from there we still saw the building dance in tune with the horrifying rattle. Scary as it was, there was this one companion of ours who made himself comfortable in the Chapel, he never panicked or tried to run out.



Disciples of the Lord also had this near death experience in the boat that was tossed by the violent storm and explosive waves. They knew that Jesus was with them. The Seminarian also realised that there was Jesus' presence during the severe earth quake. That gave him strength to face it with courage.

Yes dear friends, if Jesus is with us, even if we are tossed by the waves of life's challenges, be it physical, emotional or spiritual, we can overcome. Jesus is Emmanuel, 'God with us.' Let us hold on to him, and he will not let us sink.
