## **COVID Restrictions easing in NSW from Dec 15**

The NSW Government has committed to the easing of COVID restrictions and from Wednesday 15 December, the following will apply:

1) No density limits will apply in any venue, including Places of Worship.

2) Electronic sign-in will REMAIN mandatory in a number of venues, <u>including Places of Worship</u> by one of the following methods:

- An individual using their device to check in with the venue's QR Code

- Welcomers assist those without their own device by checking them in via the Service NSW webform associated with your parishes' COVID Safe Business registration.

- **Please note** – QR Codes are no longer mandatory for parish offices and meeting rooms.

3) Singing and dancing is allowed by all.

Face masks are no longer mandatory but are **strongly encouraged**, particularly when social distancing is not possible.
