

On Saturday the 19th of November, the Diocese will celebrate Local World Youth Day. At the 5pm vigil mass, families and young adults from across the Diocese will join us to celebrate. Following the mass, there will be an outdoor festival in the Parish car park with live music, food and games.

In addition to inviting you to join this celebration, we would like to notify you that parking will be restricted on this day as the main upper carpark will be blocked off to make room for the outdoor festival. Available parking will include the CatholicCare carpark, the lower level carpark, the basketball court and street parking. For those with accessibility requirements, please notify the car park marshals and they will direct you to park along the side of the driveway.

WYD DIOCESAN GATHERING 19 NOVEMBER

Pope Francis invites dioceses around the world to celebrate World Youth Day at local gatherings on the Feast of Christ the King.

We invite you to join us, on Saturday 19 November.

The day will consist of:

- Optional pilgrimage from St Agatha's Pennant Hills to OLOR Cathedral. The group will gather in the carpark at 1.45 pm and leaving at 2 pm. There will be a short stop for prayer at Headen Park from 2.40 pm to 3.00 pm – those who wish for a shorter walk can join the pilgrimage here at 2.40 pm. The pilgrimage will then continue and arrive at the cathedral at 4.15 pm.
- From 4.30 pm to 4.50 pm, there will be a time of prayer and testimony inside the Cathedral.
- The Cathedral Vigil Mass will occur at 5 pm.
- From 6 pm to 8 pm there will be a festival time for youth, young adults and, families with live music, free food, games and stalls.
