CHRISTMAS MESSAGE FROM FR BRENDAN LEE

How can we know that Jesus was sent by God?

Many have turned up in history and said “Here I am”. However, there is one area that is known by God and God alone, and that is the future.

Jesus Christ is the one and only person in history who was pre-announced. The passage of Isaiah 7:14 “The Virgin will conceive and give birth to a Son” dates back some 740 years before the birth of Christ. The Scriptures prophesied that he would belong to the tribe of Judah (Gen 49.10) Tenth Century B.C. That he would be from the line of King David (Isaiah 11) was prophesied 740 years before Christ. That he would be born in Bethlehem was prophesied by the prophet Micah 701 years before Christ. That He would be sold for thirty silver pieces and that the silver will be used to purchase the potter's field (Zachariah 11) was prophesied 520-518 years before Christ. That his hands and feet would be pierced and garments divided (Psalm 21) was prophesied around 1000 years before Christ was born.

We have waited for Jesus all Advent and now, He is here. Merry Christmas everyone!
