|  Set a positive example by being respectful and kind toward others |  Give clear and consistent boundaries so your child knows what's expected |
|  Learn about child development and what is typical behaviour for your child's age |  Try and remain calm in front of your kids during challenging situations |
|  Use time together to have conversations with your child |  Strike a balance between work and family to reduce stress |
|  Regularly spend time together |  Seek a healthy outlet for your frustrations and worries |
|  Know that as your child gets older they need space to explore and express their independence |  Praise your child's healthy and appropriate behaviour and give specific feedback about what they did well |
|  Look after yourself – it's much harder to support your child when you're tired and run down |  Find opportunities to involve your child in family life and decision making that is appropriate for their age |
