The Sunday before Ash Wednesday is traditionally Catechist Sunday in the Diocese and this year will be held on **Sunday 11 February 2024**. Catechist Sunday is an annual event in the CCD Calendar.

Catechist Sunday originated in 1935 when the Vatican published a document 'On the Better Care and Promotion of Catechetical Education', which acknowledged the importance of the Church's teaching ministry and asked every country to honour those catechists who serve within their Christian communities.
