DIOCESAN COUNT OF MASS ATTENDANCE NOVEMBER 2024

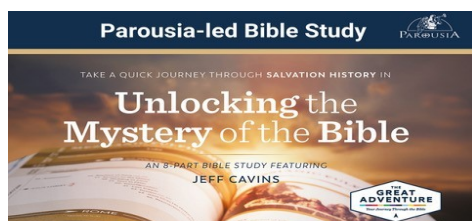
A Diocesan Head count takes place annually during the month of May.
