The Church in Australia needs its young people to be energised.

According to a report from the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference released last year, the average age of Catholics in Australia is on the rise.

During the Synod on Synodality, Pope Francis spoke to young people within the Church, urging them to remain energised.

Comparing young people to water, the Holy Father said: "When water flows, it's good, but when water stops, it ends badly."

Just as stagnant water gets contaminated with "little creatures," Pope Francis warned, "the young person who is tired is the first to be corrupted."
