Music This Weekend

This week we mark the Fourth Sunday of Lent, known as Laetare Sunday. This name derives from the first few Latin words of the Entrance Antiphon prescribed for this Mass: Laetare Jerusalem et conventum facite... (Rejoice, Jerusalem, and be glad...). The Church gives us this day of celebration as a respite, while we journey through the penitential season of Lent. While musical instruments should be more subdued during Lent (and only played to support the singing at Mass), as is tradition to mark Laetare Sunday our Cathedral organists will be playing instrumental voluntaries before Mass.
