

LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Acts 10:34,37-43

Responsorial Psalm: This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad.

Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-4

Gospel Acclamation: Christ has become our paschal sacrifice; let us feast with joy in the Lord.

Gospel: John 20:1-9

This Holy Week, we are invited to enter deeply into the sacred mystery of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

On **Holy Thursday**, we celebrate the **Mass of the Lord's Supper** at **8pm** at **OLOR Cathedral**, receiving the gift of the Eucharist and Christ's call to loving service.

Good Friday invites us to stand at the Cross, reflecting on His sacrifice. Stations of the Cross will be held at 10am at both OLOR Cathedral and Queen of Peace Church, followed by the liturgy of the Lord's Passion at 3pm.

Holy Saturday is a day of silence and hope, leading to the **Easter Vigil** at **7pm** at OLOR Cathedral —a powerful liturgy where darkness gives way to light and we proclaim with joy, *"Christ is risen!"*

This year, we are especially blessed to welcome into the Church four catechumens who have journeyed through the **RCIA program**: **Katherine Hale, Christopher Taylor, Thisara Alawala, and Buddhika Akaranthilaka**. At the Easter Vigil, they will be fully initiated into the Catholic faith—an occasion of great joy for our entire parish family.

Easter Sunday brings the joy of the Risen Lord and the promise of new life. Masses will follow the regular Sunday schedule.

We warmly encourage you to join us for these sacred days. May this Holy Week renew your faith and draw you ever closer to the love of Christ.
