

LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Acts 5:27-32. 40-41

Responsorial Psalm:

I will praise you, Lord, for you have rescued me.

Second Reading: Rev 5:11-14

Gospel Acclamation:

Christ is risen, the Lord of all creation; he has shown pity on all people.

Gospel: John 21:1-19

Called, Forgiven, Sent

The Risen Jesus meets His disciples at the shore, turning their failure into fruitfulness and gently restoring Peter with love and purpose. In Acts, we see that same Peter now courageously witnessing to Christ despite persecution. Heaven itself rejoices in the Lamb who was slain, whose sacrifice brings life.

Easter is not only about the empty tomb—it is about how we respond. Jesus calls us again today: "Follow me." No matter our past, He offers restoration and mission.

As the Church awaits the election of a new pope, let us pray for the cardinals in the Conclave—that the Holy Spirit may guide them to choose a shepherd after Christ's own heart, one who will feed His sheep with wisdom, compassion and courage.

The Rite of Confirmation for Adults is on 8 June 2025. If you are 16 years or older, have been baptised, and wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, deadline for enrollment is 9 May.
