Gospel: John 13:31-35

Love One Another

In this Sunday's Gospel (John 13:31–35), Jesus speaks to His disciples shortly after Judas leaves to begin his betrayal. Knowing His time is short, Jesus gives them a new commandment: "Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." These are not just words of comfort but a call to action. Jesus invites us to love with the same selfgiving and merciful love He shows us. This is how the world will recognize His followers—not by title or status, but by love in action.

As we continue in the Easter season, may we reflect on how we are living out this call in our families, communities, and everyday encounters.

Sacrament of Confirmation. We are blessed to have 77 children preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation this year, along with 6 adult candidates journeying toward their own Confirmation. As they continue their preparation, we invite you to keep them in your prayers, that they may be strengthened by the Holy Spirit and grow deeper in faith.
