### Peace be with you

In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them." This speaks to the heart of discipleship: love shown through obedience, and a life shaped by Jesus' teachings. When we live this way, God doesn't remain distant—He comes close and makes His home within us.

As He prepares to return to the Father, **Jesus offers two lasting gifts. First, the Holy Spirit—the Advocate**—who teaches and reminds us of His words. **Second, His peace.** "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you." This peace is not like the world's, but a deep calm rooted in God's constant love.

In a world that often leaves us anxious, Jesus gently reminds us: "Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." His peace is a gift for those who welcome His word and remain in His love.

This Easter season, may we open our hearts to God's presence, allowing His Spirit to guide us and His peace to dwell within us.

**Get involved in Parish life.** Jesus reminds us that loving Him means living His word. One way we do that is by serving others in our community.

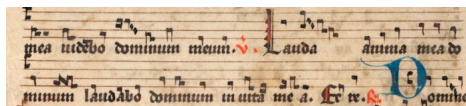
