LITURGY OF THE WORD



First Reading: Proverbs 8:22-31

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 8:4-9. R. v.2

O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!

Second Reading: Romans 5:1-5

Gospel Acclamation:

Glory to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit: to God who is, who was and who is to come.

Gospel: John 16:12-15

The Most Holy Trinity – Guided by the Spirit of Truth

In this Sunday's Gospel (John 16:12–15), Jesus speaks tenderly to His disciples: "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now." He reassures them with a promise—the Holy Spirit will come, sent by the Father, to guide them into all truth. This intimate moment unveils the beautiful unity of the Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—distinct yet perfectly one—working in harmony to reveal the fullness of God's love.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we are reminded that this divine communion is not a distant mystery but a living relationship that invites us in. The Holy Spirit, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, continues to dwell within us—teaching, guiding, and helping us live out what Jesus has revealed.

As we now enter Ordinary Time in the Church's liturgical calendar, let us not think of it as "ordinary" in the usual sense, but as a sacred opportunity—a season to grow deeper in our faith, to reflect more intentionally on the teachings of Jesus, and to live more fully in the love of the Trinity.

May our lives reflect that same love, unity, and openness to God's presence.
