## Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus

Christi) In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus feeds the multitude with five loaves and two fish—an abundant miracle that points us to the gift of the *Eucharist.* Just as the crowd was nourished and satisfied, so too are we spiritually fed each time we receive the Body and Blood of Christ.

On this Solemnity of Corpus Christi, we are invited to reflect more deeply on the mystery and miracle of the Eucharist. Christ is not only our teacher and healer—He is our nourishment. In every Mass, He gives Himself completely, that we may never hunger or thirst again.

#### Come to the table. Receive Jesus with reverence and faith. Let His presence transform your heart and your life.
