Gospel: Matthew 16:13-19

Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul

Peter and Paul were very differentone a humble fisherman, the other a well-educated Pharisee-but both were radically transformed by their encounter with Christ. Peter's bold declaration of faith, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:16), became the foundation of the Church. Paul's tireless missionary journeys and powerful letters brought the Gospel to the Gentiles and helped shape the early Christian communities (2) Timothy 4:6–8).

Despite their flaws—Peter's denial and Paul's past persecution of Christians-God called and equipped them for a greater purpose. Their lives show us that no one is too broken or unworthy to be used by God.

Together, Peter and Paul remind us that the Church is built not on perfection, but on faith, surrender, and grace.

This week, ask yourself: How is God calling me to share my faith, even in small ways? Like Peter and Paul, may we live with courage, trust in God's mercy, and a desire to bring others closer to Christ.
