



LITURGY OF THE WORD



First Reading: Isaiah 66:10-14

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 65:1-7,16, 20

Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

Second Reading: Galatians 6:14-18

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia May the peace of Christ rule in your hearts; and the fullness of his message live within you.

Gospel: Luke 10:1-12. 17-20

Jesus sends the seventy-two.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus sends seventy-two disciples ahead of Him, calling them to bring His peace and proclaim that "the kingdom of God is very near." As baptised Catholics, we too are sent to share Christ's peace and mercy with the world.

Jesus urges His disciples to trust completely in God's providence and remain faithful, even when they face rejection. He reminds them—and usthat true joy is not found in successes or power, but in knowing we belong to God: "Rejoice rather that your names are written in heaven.'

This week, let us ask ourselves: How can I bring Christ's peace to my home, workplace, or parish? May we go forth with courage, sharing God's love with all we meet.


