

# Who is my neighbour?

## LITURGY OF THE WORD

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia Your words, Lord, are spirit and life; you have the words of everlasting life.

Gospel: Luke 10:25-37

#### Parable of the Good Samaritan

In today's Gospel, Jesus responds to the question, "Who is my neighbour?" with the parable of the Good Samaritan—a powerful lesson on mercy in action. While religious figures pass by a man left beaten on the road, it is the Samaritan, an outsider, who stops, tends his wounds, and ensures his care. Jesús' command is clear: "Go and do likewise."

This parable calls us to extend compassion beyond boundaries of familiarity or comfort. To love our neighbour is to respond generously to those in need, recognising Christ in each person we encounter.

As we reflect on this Gospel, may we examine our own hearts: Are we willing to be interrupted by the needs of others? Do we allow compassion to guide our actions? May the grace of this Sunday's liturgy move us to live out the Gospel command with renewed generosity and love.
