LITURGY OF THE WORD



First Reading: Genesis 18:1-10

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 14:2-5. R. v.1

The just will live in the presence of the Lord.

Second Reading: Colossians 1:24-28

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia

Happy are they who have kept the word with a generous heart and yield harvest through perseverance.

Gospel: Luke 10:38-42

Choosing the better part.

In today's Gospel, **Jesus visits the home of Martha and Mary**. While Martha is busy with many tasks of hospitality, Mary simply sits at the feet of Jesus, listening attentively. When Martha complains, Jesus gently reminds her that while many things may seem urgent, **"there is need of only one thing."** Mary has chosen the better part: being present to the Lord.

Reflect: Are we so caught up in the busyness of life — even in doing good — that we forget to make space for the Lord? Jesus reminds us that time spent in prayer, listening to His Word, and resting in His presence is not wasted time; it is the foundation for everything else. **Before we serve, we must first sit at the feet of Christ.** Prayer grounds our work in peace, not anxiety.

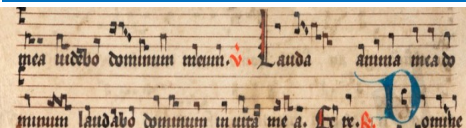
