Ask, Seek, Knock: A Life of Trusting Prayer

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus teaches not just how to pray, but how to trust. When the disciples ask, "Lord, teach us to pray," Jesus responds with the simple yet profound Our Father. This prayer reminds us to come to God like children — asking for our needs, seeking forgiveness, and desiring His guidance.

Jesus urges us to ask, seek, and knock with persistence. He assures us that God's generosity surpasses even the love of human parents. If we trust, God will surely give us what is good — especially the gift of the Holy Spirit.

This Gospel invites us to make prayer our first response, trusting in God's wisdom, love, and perfect timing.

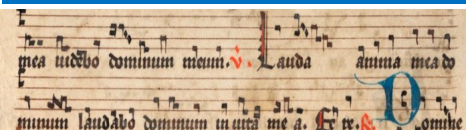
