LITURGY OF THE WORD



"What shall I do, for I do not have space to store my harvest." Luke 12:17

First Reading: Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23

In every age, O Lord, you have been our refuge.

Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11

Gospel: Luke 12:13-21

Where is your treasure?

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that *true security is not found in wealth or possessions, but in our relationship with God*. The parable of the rich man shows the danger of storing up treasures for ourselves while neglecting what really matters — being "rich in the sight of God."

It's easy to become caught up in comfort, success, or planning for the future, but Jesus calls us to focus on eternal things: love, generosity, faith, and trust in God's providence.

The readings today challenge us to ask: What am I storing up in my life? Are my priorities aligned with eternal things? True riches lie in faith, love, generosity, and trust in God's providence.

A reminder that the **Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary** is a *Holy Day of Obligation*. All Catholics are called to attend Mass as we honour Mary, assumed body and soul into heaven — a sign of hope and the destiny God desires for all of us who live in His grace. Mass times are:

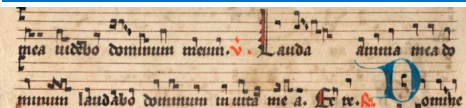
