Be Ready, Be Faithful

"Be as servants, wide awake at the return of their master."

Jesus reminds us today that discipleship means living in constant readiness—not out of fear, but out of love and trust in God. "Do not be afraid, little flock," He says, assuring us of the Father's generous heart.

To be ready means to be faithful in the small things: showing kindness, living justly, praying daily, and using our time well. Whether we're at work, home, or church, each moment is a chance to serve and be found ready.

Ask yourself:

- Am I attentive to God's presence each day?
- Would the Lord find me faithful if He came today?

Let's stay awake—not just with open eyes, but with open hearts—ready to welcome the Lord whenever He comes..

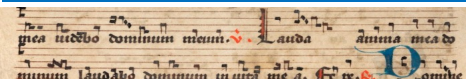
