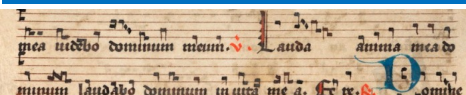

Congregational Singing in Mass

The 1967 Vatican document *Musicae Sacram* (Sacred Music) built upon the work of the Second Vatican Council in encouraging the "active participation" of all the assembly at Mass. It states: "One cannot find anything more religious and more joyful in sacred celebrations than a whole congregation expressing its faith and devotion in song."

While emphasising the importance of the assembly's participation, space is also allowed for the Choir to occasionally sing a piece by themselves, to enrich the liturgy with sacred music beyond the scope of an unrehearsed assembly. When this takes place, the assembly is still encouraged to actively participate by: "uniting themselves interiorly to what the ministers or choir sing, so that by listening to them they may raise their minds to God."
