The pipe organ is to be held in high esteem in the Latin Church, since it is its traditional instrument, the sound of which can add a wonderful splendor to the Church's ceremonies and powerfully lift up men's minds to God and higher things. The use of other instruments may also be admitted in divine worship, provided that the instruments are suitable for sacred use, that they are in keeping with the dignity of the temple, and truly contribute to the edification of the faithful.
