

On this All Souls' Day, we remember our loved ones in the light of Jesus' promise: "Whoever comes to me, I will never turn away... and I shall raise them up on the last day." (John 6:37-40)

In the Psalms, we find the assurance of God's steadfast love—echoing the Church's belief that our prayers for the departed spring from hearts attuned to His compassion.

This is why the Church continues to offer the Eucharist and prayers for all who have gone before us, that they may be granted light, peace, and eternal rest. St. Paul assures us that nothing—not even death—can separate us from the love of Christ. In faith, we commend our loved ones to God's mercy, confident that they remain united with us in the communion of saints and share our hope in the resurrection to eternal
